MPs will vote this Wednesday on amendments to the Crimimal Justice Bill currently passing through Parliament. One pro-abortion amendment, proposed by Diana Johnson, would remove any legal protection from unborn babies where a woman seeks to bring about her own abortion at any stage of the pregnancy. Another, proposed by Stella Creasy, seeks to decriminalise abortion up to the 24th week for any party involved, and could therefore put vulnerable women under pressure to abort outside of a medical setting, thereby putting her health at risk as well as ending the unborn child's life. At the other end life, media pressure is mounting for MPs to support a change to the laws

surrounding assisted suicide. If you haven't seen it already, do try and watch actress Liz Carr's excellent documentary 'Better Off Dead?' which can be found on the BBC iplayer. Carr draws out the impact any change in legislation would have on those living with disabilities. It is a powerful and moving documentary.
